- Shared calendar
- Shared client lists and time sheet

Often: additional restrictions



Rules to change?

- Physical office with the necessary infrastructure to receive a client
- Referral fees and sharing of fees
- Prohibition of external equity in laws firms
- Prohibition of integrated association with other professions



Other challenges

- Use of legal platforms (legal services provided online)
- Legal platforms organized by law firms
- Legal platforms of third parties (quid sharing of fees?)

- Use of AI (i.a. predictive justice)
- Possibility to provide legal services outside the traditional framework of the legal profession
