- Young Lawyer Sponsorship
 - To attend international conferences and Mainland study tours
- Korean and Japanese Internship Programmes
 - Co-organised with Korean Bar Association, Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Korea and Japan Federation of Bar Associations since 2014
 - Two-week training in local law firms
- MOU signing with International Association of Young Lawyers (AIJA)





Belt and Road Initiative

- 1st Belt and Road Conference (May 2017)
 - Theme: "A Catalyst for Connectivity, Convergence and Collaboration"
 - Attended by nearly 600 overseas and local delegates
 - 39 lawyers' associations from 24 jurisdictions signed the Hong Kong Manifesto, pledging to promote synergy, strategic partnership and collaboration amongst the signing organisations
- 2nd Belt and Road Conference (September 2018)
 - Theme: "The ABC to Building a Smart Belt and Road: Law and Artificial Intelligence, Blockchain and Cloud"
 - Attended by over 650 overseas and local delegates
 - 34 lawyers' associations from 17 jurisdictions signed the *LawTech Alliance*, pledging to promote a shared ethical A.I. framework among lawyers from the Belt and Road regions

Greater China events

- Organised 32 outbound visits and events to 23 cities in Greater China in 2018
- As of September 2019: 35 outbound and inbound events:
 - Regular lectures for trainee lawyers in the Guangdong province (since November 2018)
 - A common law course for Peking University Law School in Beijing (March & June 2019)
 - Straits Law Forum in Xiamen (August 2019)
 - HKTDC "SmartHK" in Guangzhou (August 2019)



Greater China events (cont'd)

- Visit to Hainan (August 2019)
 - Led a 20-member delegation to visit Hainan free trade zone
 - Organised full-day seminar with Hainan Lawyers Associations







Greater China events (cont'd)

- Cross Strait Four Regions Young Lawyers Forum (20 Sep 2019)
 - Theme: "Retrospect and Prospect A New Legal Generation in Greater China"
 - Roundtable meeting for head delegates from participating lawyers associations, organisation visits and welcome reception will also be arranged
 - Expected to attract over 160 legal practitioners from Mainland China,
 Taiwan and Macau







Greater Bay Area

- Consists of nine affluent cities in the Guangdong Province in addition to Hong Kong and Macao
- A population of 70 million and an aggregated GDP of US\$1.5 trillion
- The Law Society's work:
 - Completed three visits to the nine cities in the Greater Bay Area in 2018
 - Arranged a series of activities and seminars, as well as RME courses and practice management courses, for lawyers in the Greater Bay Area
 - Launched a joint meeting system with all the lawyers associations in the Greater Bay Area
